# 2023/34 FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR 2023/24

#### (a) Overview report for Quarter 1 2023/24

### 2023/35 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND GRANT APPLICATION

Committee considered a grant application from the Inner Wheel of Chard, which, due to a change in coverage of rental of areas of the Guildhall after the initial submission, was increased to £500 from the original request of £391.20. Members agreed that the Community Showcase is a fantastic event for the community but that it should be self-funding in future years.
