- 7. New applications to vote by proxy except on the grounds of a medical emergency must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Council Offices Brympton Way Yeovil by 5.00 pm on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2023, if they are to be effective for this election.
- 8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Brympton Way, Yeovil BA20 2HT by 5.00 pm on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023.
